Public Transport Guide

There are 3 alternative options from Rome:

1) regional bus from ROMA - Cornelia [Metro A] to Cerveteri

see servizi.cotralspa.it/Orari

2) train from 'Roma Termini' to 'Ladispoli-Cerveteri' (stopping also in many other stations inside Rome)

and then local bus to Cerveteri

3) From <http://www.trenitalia.com> you can also buy a **combined ticket for train + bus**

search for 'CERVETERI NECROPOLI' and you get the connection without checking buses timetable or buying two tickets (good option but not the best timing for competition though)

In any case if you end in Cerveteri you can walk to event center
(600m Saturday - 1500m Sunday)

There's a small chance that you find a local bus to the event center but frequency is very low
(look for 'Necropoli di Cerveteri' or 'via della Necropoli' in the timetable)

BE CAREFUL:

TRAIN STATION 'Ladispoli-Cerveteri' is in Ladispoli (6km from Cerveteri)

TRAIN STATION 'Marina di Cerveteri' is also called 'Cerenova FS' in the bus timetable

FS mean trains (Ferrovie dello Stato - old name of Trenitalia)
